

- 6) The Maruti Gypsy, with an armed guard onboard, shall form part of the rear of the Convoy and the effort shall be made to keep the vehicles of the Convoy as close as possible to each other for proper and the effective regulation of the convoy.
- 7) The motorcycles will have a green flag mounted on them, tied with the help of a stick, whereas, Maruti gypsies shall carry a red flag, affixed properly on the vehicle.
- 8) The In-charges of both the JPPs, under the close supervision of SHOs Baratang/Bambooflat, shall ensure proper maintenance and parking of the motorcycles and Gypsies. They shall also ensure the availability of adequate quantity of POL for the smooth, efficient and uninterrupted regulation of the Convoys. Any discrepancy/shortcoming shall be brought to the notice of the senior officers immediately by the I/Cs JPPs and the SHOs concerned.
- 9) The idea of causing the least disturbance to/interference in the way of life of members of Jarawa tribe should be kept in the mind. The staff deployed may be briefed suitably and thoroughly in this regard.
- 10) If any vehicle of the Convoy breaks down, a police personnel, deployed in the said Convoy, shall guard the vehicle and the passengers of the said vehicle, if possible, shall be put on the STS bus or in any other suitable mode of transport otherwise the passengers would stay seated inside the vehicle and all efforts shall be made to ensure that passengers/tourists do not loiter around and interact with Jarawas, if any.
- 11) No body shall be allowed to indulge in photography and even seemingly innocent and/or innocuous interaction with the jawaras. The exchange of articles like biscuits, bananas, any other food material and tobacco etc shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
- 12) Any untoward incident/happening shall be brought to the notice of ICs/JPPs Jirkatang and Middle Strait, who, in turn, shall cause to transmit the same to the Control Room and senior officers at the earliest.
- 13) I/Cs JPPs under the supervision of the SHOs concerned shall ensure regular and effective patrolling on the ATR and picketing in co-ordination with the AAJVS personnel at Poona Nallah, Potatang and RK Nallah in the reserve area, without fail. At least, one police personnel along with one Home Guard shall be deployed at these places. The deployment at Poona Nallah and Potatang shall be done by the I/C Jirkatang whereas the deployment at R K Nallah shall be done by I/C JPP Middle Strait.
