PREAMBLE:

This long communion Protocol is in no very intended to exuse or force resettlement or relocation of Scheduled Tribes and Other Forest Dwellers from National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries, but to facilitate the determinition and natification of Critical Wildlife Habitats following due process of law. This conformity with the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forests Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is a mandatory requirement.

BACKGROUND:

The revised guidelines were assection of February 2011, in supercession of the previous guidelines. However, there was in impression that these earlier guidelines (25th October 2007) were not fully in transmance with the spirit of the FRA, 2006, and therefore, a meeting was called under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) MoEF on 4th March 2011 to address these concerns. Following the discussions in the meeting, it was decided to withdraw the guidelines of 7th February 2011, and rework these to accommodate all genuine concerns.
- Therefore, this Protocol has been framed to determine and notify CWH within National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries, to harmonize the provisions of the FRA, 2006 and the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, and to address concerns of conservation of wildlife and its habitat, while safeguarding the forest rights of the Scheduled Tribes and that Ferest Dwellers

OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of this Protocol is to give effect to the provisions of the FRA, 2006, which envisages the creation of inviolate CWH within National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries, so as to ensure the conservation of, and the prevention of damage to, windlife and its habital within the determined area.
