

Organizing of training programmes in poultry, goat & pig farming.

Fisheries:

50% subsidy on supply of outboard/inboard engine & fishing inputs, fish transport vehicles to tribal fisherman. Organizing of training programmes tribal fisherman. Financial assistance for loss of fishing implements, crafts and gear due to natural calamities etc.

Village & Small Scale Industries:

50% subsidy for procurement of pollution control equipments; captive power generations sets, copra dryer, coir processing &, bakery equipments; hand tools for general engineering, carpentry & masonry.

Education:

Tribal children are provided with bicycles, schools stationeries, incentives to the girl children; free text books and note books; hostel accommodation and free uniforms up to Senior Secondary level; exposure trip to mainland for tribal boys and girls; post matric scholarships and scholarships for higher studies in mainland, cooked Mid Day Meal is extended to tribal children up to Middle stage; training of teachers for qualitative improvement etc. One residential school in tribal district of Nicobar has been constructed with provision of sufficient accommodation for the girls. One Navodaya Vidyalaya is exists in Nicobar District. There is one Govt. Polytechnic available for catering to the need of vocational and professional education at Port Blair with sufficient reservation for accommodating the tribal candidates. There are 21 Primary school, 10 Middle school, 6 Secondary school and 5 Sr. Secondary school in the tribal area.

Health :

Special steps are taken to provide better health services through health institutions established in scattered islands of Tribal area. Separate section of Tribal Health is established to collect/compile the data of tribals. Sufficient
