Regulation by exclusively preserving the area for them in which they enjoy unfettered rights to use forest products for their bonafide use, so no claim as such is there for settlement under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.

As regards, other Traditional
Forest Dwellers, nobody
qualifies for being the
traditional forest dwellers
having resided on the forest
land/ tribal reserve for the
bonafide livelihood needs for
three generations (75 years),
prior to 13.12.2005 for the
purpose of recognition of
forest right under the above
