

Regulation, Tribes) 1956 and since their interests are fully protected under the said Regulation exclusively preserving the area for them in which they enjoy unfettered rights to use forest products for their bonafide use, so no claim as such is there for settlement under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition Forest Rights) Act, 2006.

As regards, other Traditional Forest Dwellers, nobody qualifies for being the traditional forest dwellers having resided on the forest land/ tribal reserve for the bonafide livelihood needs for three generations (75 years),
