All the above detailed mammals, reptiles, and birds have been found in the Island. Habitat degradation, hunting have declined these wildlife to the extent that some of the species are at rare sighting, hence, the conservation of these wildlife is to be concentrated upon studies on ecology and habitat, breeding mechanism, studies on alternative habitat considering the developmental activities, strengthening of protective measures in the isolated Islands by way of transport and communication. Creating awareness among temporary residents i.e Security personnels, general public, fishing communities is therefore suggested for the improvement of the status of wildlife in the Island which is an immediate need for the declared Wildlife Sanctuary.

Status of Flora of East islands

The Island sanctuary is with the greenery of Andaman tropical Evergreen Forest, Andaman Tropical Moist Deciduous Forest. The details of the flora of the Island is furnished herewith.
