There are abundance of pole crops on the under canopy below the girth of 30 cms predominantly of the spp like Latauk, Lea indica, Jungli neem, Murraya spp, bakri patti, Thatching leaf (*Licuala* Spp) found in the island area.

Site Inspection Report :-

With reference to the letter No. 767 dt. 27.08.2012 received from the Mukhalaya, Tatrakshak Kshetra, headquarters, coast guard region (A&N) Port Blair and endorsement of PCCF (WL) vide L.No. CWLW/WL/207/332 dt. 06.09.2012 a proposal has been submitted for diversion of land for installation of coastal surveillance network in east Island by the Indian Coast Guard, for remote monitoring and strengthening coastal security mechanism by instituting various measures including setting up of coastal radar chain within the existing premises of the Light house at East Island. With respect to the proposal on 14th September 2012 a team of forest officers and officials headed by Shri. S. K. Thomas, Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Mayabunder accompanied by Dr. Dinesh Kannan, Divisional Forest Officer, Diglipur, Shri. A. Soundrapandian, Range Officer, Kalara Wildlife Range along with the following staff of forest department of Kalara Wildlife Range:-

1. Shri. Micah, Forester
2. Shri. Hemant Kr lakra, Forest guard.

Had proceeded to East Island along with the Coast Guard authorities and officials of Indian Coast Guard Ship, C-45 at 9.00 hrs from Aerial bay Diglipur and upon reaching east island at 10.30 hrs the Coast Guard officer, Asst. Commandant Shri. J.P. Shukla posted at Coast guard headquarters at Diglipur briefed about the proposal and have shown the site of installation of Radar Station at East Island about 60 mts towards the eastern side of East Island Light House. As per the noted landmark the East Island Light House the proposed site is located at the earmarked position:-
