

Deputy Commissioners of the District to initiate necessary to review the rejected claims and the State would start suo- moto review of the rejected cases. Since the review process is still going on in the State the final figures pertaining to finally rejected Cases which would lead to eviction are not available.

Presentation by Bihar:

Total 4,696 FRA claims have been received in the State out of which 4,252 claims have been rejected which is quite high. The State informed that details are being collected from the districts regarding whether the claimants were given opportunity to adduce evidence and the State has not carried out de- duplication exercise has carried out by the States. The State has reported that as per the report received from the concerned districts, no eviction exercise needs to be undertaken.

Presentation by Chhattisgarh:

Total 4,54,379 claims have been rejected so far consisting of 2,54,411 ST claims and 1,99,968 OTFD claims which are under review/ scrutiny and figures of finally rejected claims at DLC level are not given as the same is under review/ scrutiny Since the review process is going on the number of finally rejected cases which can lead to eviction is not readily available. Regarding procedure followed while rejecting FRA claims, written information has not been served to the claimants. The State is undertaking the suo- moto review of rejected claims at all levels. De- duplication exercise is also being carried out by the State through on line portal and exercise is yet to be completed. Further, workshops for field functionaries including FRC members is being organized by district administration so the provisions of FRA in cases of reconsideration of such claims may be implemented flawlessly.
