Further the said Article also specifically provides that no Act of Parliament in respect of ownership and transfer of land and its resources shall apply to the State of Nagaland unless the Legislative Assembly of Nagaland by a resolution so decides. Till now, no resolution is passed by the Legislative Assembly to make FRA, 2006 applicable to the State of Nagaland. Since the inapplicability of the Act, no procedure has taken place under the said Act and the State Government has already filed affidavit before Hon'ble Supreme Court accordingly.

Presentation by Odisha:

Total 1,45,750 claims have been rejected at all levels under FRA however, at DLC level 2,216 claims have been rejected and remaining rejected cases are under appeal/ review process. Out of total 2,216 rejected claims, 1,014 rejected individual claims may lead to eviction. Regarding appeals and suo- moto review of the rejected claims, if appeals are not filed by claimants before the SDLC and DLC, then suo- moto appeals are being taken up.

Presentation by Rajasthan:

A.

In the State, total 76,714 claims have been received in which 37,352 claims have been rejected consisting of 36,711 ST claims and 571 OTFD claims. However, at the level of DLCs, 856 claims have been rejected. The meeting of the State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) has been held under Chairpersonship of the Chief Secretary. SLMC is also reviewing the rejected claims through FRA Portal on regular basis. It has also been ordered by SLMC to enter all the accepted claims in revenue record. As per Action Taken Report submitted by the State Government of Rajasthan, due procedure as prescribed under FRA, 2006 and FR Rules made thereunder is being followed by the State Government for reviewing the rejected
