

claims and pending claims at all levels with the help of organising special camps and inspections. The State Government has informed about the relevant laws under which eviction can be made under relevant State Government laws.

Presentation by Telangana:

Total 82,075 claims have been rejected, out of them, information regarding 51,289 is available. In cases of rejected claims, the reasons are informed to the claimants orally and they were also informed about the process of appeal. According to the State, there is very little scope for appeals or suo moto review as the rejections largely pertain to reasons which are not permissible as per Act. Further, 6,612 claims have rejected finally at the DLC level. Since, none of the rejected claimants are forcibly continuing their occupation as on date. Hence the need for eviction does not arise.

Presentation by Tamil Nadu:

Total 10,656 FRA claims have been rejected at different levels in the State however, 4 individual claims have been rejected at DLC level. Chief Secretary has conducted review meeting with all concerned District Collectors through video conference and awareness creation programmes and training programmes were conducted for stake holders. In rejected cases, the due procedure was not followed hence review process is under progress through providing opportunity of appeal to the claimants.

Presentation by Tripura:

Total 68,388 FRA individual claims have been rejected out of 2,00,358 received FRA claims and number of finally rejected individual claims at DLC level is 2,300. A web- site has been designed for database of all rejected claims is open in rejected
