Functions of the District Level Committee

- (1) The District Level Committee shall;
- examine whether all claims have been addressed keeping in mind the objectives of the Act;

consider and finally approve the claims and record of forest rights (b) prepared by the Sub-Divisional Level Committee;

hear petitions from persons aggrieved by the orders of the Sub-Divisional (c) Level Committee;

co-ordinate with other districts regarding inter-district claims; (d)

- issue directions for incorporation of the forest rights in the relevant (e) government records including record rights.
- (2) The District Level Committee shall also;
- facilitate the Gram Sabha in accessing government documents, and other relevant information in determining forest rights and provide technical (a) assistance if required;

ensure dissemination process and awareness programmes on the Act (b) and rules made there under;

ensure that the Gram Sabhas are conducted in a free, open and representative manner with full and unrestricted participation of women. (c)

(3) The District Collector or Deputy Commissioner shall responsible for;

publishing the record of forest rights as finalized by the District Level

ensure that a certified copy of the record of forest rights and title under the Act, as specified in Annexure-II, is provided to the concerned claimant (b) and the Gram Sabha and publicity posted at convenient places in the village:

Functions of the Sub-Divisional Level Committee

The Sub-Divisional Level Committee shall;

- provide forest and revenue maps and electoral rolls to the Gram Sabha or (a) the forest rights Committee.
- collate all the resolutions of the concerned Gram Sabhas;

consolidate maps and details provided by the Gram Sabhas; (b)

examine the resolutions and the maps of the Gram Sabhas to ascertain (d) the veracity of the claims;

hear and adjudicate disputes between Gram Sabhas on the nature and (e) extent of any forest rights;

hear petitions from persons aggrieved by the resolutions of the Gram (f)

co-ordinate with other Sub-Divisional Level Committee for inter sub-(g)

prepare block/tehsil-wise the draft record of forest rights divisional clams; (h) reconciliation of government records.

forward the claims with the draft record of forest rights through the Sub-Divisional Officer to the District Level Committee for final decision; (i)

raise awareness through workshops and other means about the objectives, provisions and procedures of the Acts and in rule 25(4) (j)

ensure easy and free availability of proforma of claims to the claimants as (k) provided in Annexure - I.
