Terms of Reference.

- (1) To review the programmes and measures taken so far for protection of STs and elimination of exploitation of tribals in the field of land alienation, forest, moneylending, bonded labour and excise etc.
- (2) To critically examine the adequacy or other-wise of laws and regulations in the field of land, moneylending, forest etc.
- (3) To suggest measures including cooperatives for socio-economic rehabilitation of the exploited S.Ts.
- (4) To suggest measures to protect interests of S.Ts in bio-diversity against possible onslaught of outsiders, particularly multinational companies. and
- (5) To suggest specific measures for prevention of exploitation of S.T. women.
