Terms of References:

- (1) To examine the extent of the tribals' participation in administration planning and implementation of various developmental programmes for STs.
- (2) To examine the possibility of decentralisation of various powers and functions to Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) and urban local bodies (U.C.Bs) in the context of the Constitution (73rd & 74th Amendment) Acts, 1992.
- (3) To suggest linkages between the P.R.Is. and U.L.Bs on the one hand and the I.T.D.Ps/I.T.D.A.s on the other.
- (4) To evolve modalities for involvement of traditional tribal leaders in the development process, and
- (5) To assess the possibility of and facilitating involvement of NGOs in the implementation of various socio-economic programmes.
