

Chelanaickans at Panchakelly and Alakkal are suffering from Leprosy. In the Action Plan 1994-95, it is proposed for a full fledged mobile medical unit exclusively for Chelanaickens and also setting up of three ANP Centres.

Kattunaickans suffer from sickle cell anemia, T.B. etc and also mal nutrition. As per the proposed scheme educated tribal youths would be selected as guides. Special nutrition centres in T.A. prone areas *has been proposed*

Details of only two P.T.G's have been mentioned.

### Tripura

No specific details have been given.

### Gujarat

There is no mention of specific diseases to <sup>which</sup> the P.T.Gs' are subjected. It has been reported that they are under nourished and under developed. To overcome the complications arising out of mal-nutrition and under nourishment, the children and lactating mothers as well as old and disabled persons are proposed to be supplied therapeutic feed and medicines. ~~The~~ provision of Rs.6.28 lakhs has been made which is expected to benefit about 1250 families during 1992-97.
