Pue no letter no. 22040/13/2009 - N.G.O dated 10/11/2010 from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, New Delhi regarding Grant-in-aid to Voluntary Organizations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes. As per file, it is stated that the scheme proposals received from N.G.Os seeking assistance under Central Sector schemes may be examined by the State Level Committees and may be phrased out such projects which have not well run or those projects which have attained the level of self sufficiency.

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In this regard it is stated that the Tribal Welfare Department has not engaged any N.G.Os for implementation of Tribal Welfare schemes/Plan schemes but AATVs, an autonomous body have been engaged in protection and welfare of P.T.G's. AATVs are getting Grant-in-aid under U.T. Plan schemes as well as Central Sector schemes. Since AATVs are not an N.G.O, please in future for information please.
