II. The imaginary, false and fabricated Survey Reports on Population Census, Social, Economic and Educational status of the Bengali Settlers submitted to the OBC Commission by the Administration. The Social, Economic and Educational status of the Bengali Settlers had been equated fraudulently to those of the Pre-'42 Local Borns without conducting any survey. The strong protest by the Bengal Association of A & N Islands (BAANI).had been ignored.

The former Director of the department of Statistics, A & N Administration Mr. Gihani had reportedly submitted the imaginary, false and fabricated survey reports without conducting any survey under constant threat. Mr. Gihani after superannuation went missing from Junglighat, Port Blair sometimes in 2008.

III. <u>Imaginary, Wrong and fabricated Population Census</u> submitted to the OBC Commission by the <u>A & N Administration</u>: The <u>projected population of identified communities</u> according to the Population Census <u>conducted by the A & N Administration</u> (department of Statistics, A & N Administration) is follows:—

1.	Local Born - Mixed (Pre-'42)	: 77,254
2.	Mopla	: 26,569
3.	Bhantu	: 1448
4.	Karen	: 1512
5.	Bengali Settlers – (Post-Independence)	: 57,948

This population survey is <u>completely imaginary</u>, <u>highly biased</u>, <u>false and fabricated</u>; it has been deliberately manipulated and fabricated with ulterior motive. <u>It will have provocative effect</u> on the Bengalis and may cause political, cultural, social and communal conflicts in future <u>between two communities</u>.

## IV. The factual position and the ground reality:

Bengal Association of A & N Islands (BAANI) conducted a Population Survey in 1997'98 which corroborate approximately with the figures detected on the basis of the Family
Identity Cards, Voter's Cards (Tehsil-wise), Islanders Identity Cards, Panchayat office
records, Health Records and School records.
