The whole Nicobar District is Tribal Reserve Area except seven revenue villages at the eastern coast of Great Nicobar Island where EX Servicemen have been settled in 1970's by the Government of India. These villages are not connected with any Tribal Area and all settlers in these villages are restricted for making entry in any Tribal reserved area/land of Nicobar District.

The Protection of Aboriginal Tribes (Regulation) 1956, A&N Islands is applicable in the district which restricts entry of any non
