1. The Union Territory "Andaman and Nicobar Islands" comprises of two Districts namely Andaman District and Nicobar District. In this Island territory as per the Schedule there are 6 Primitive Aboriginal Tribes inhabited viz Nicobariese, Ongese, Great-Andamanese, Sentinalese, Shompens and Jarawas. The first 3 Category tribals have been brought under the Cooperative fold. Rest of the 3 categories are yet to be brought under the main stream of Cooperation.

Nicobar District mainly concentrated with 100% tribal population of Nicobaree Tribes whose life style and economic stay is fully dependent on the Plantation Produces like Copra, Areca- nut etc. These Plantation crops are being marketed by the tribals through their primary level coop. societies functioning at the village level known as PANAM HINNENGO At present there are 30 PANAM HINNENGO of which 15 each at Car Nicobar and Nancowry Group of Islands, in Nicobar District. At the Central Level there are two Central Marketing Coop. Societies namely ELLON HINENGO LTD Car Nicobar and Manula Matai Ltd at Nancoury (Presently defunct) manned and managed by 100% tribal folks channelizing the marketing of the plantation Products of their primaries. Besides, there are other Primary Coop. Societies
