Evaluation:

1. The 6th All India Educational survey had been conducted by the department. The survey included both tribal and general area.

The 7th All India Educational survey is being conducted from 5/02. As mentioned above, the survey includes the Union Territory as a whole.

The objectives of the survey are:-

- (i) To assess the availability of schooling facility within each habitation.
- (ii) To assess the class wise enrollment, position of teachers including tribal teachers etc.
- iii. To assess the availability of basic facilities such as buildings, classrooms, drinking water, electricity, urinal etc, schoolwise.
2. As per the 6th All India Educational survey, the habitations were identified and primary schools were provided. Habitations had been selected on the basis of Programme of action where population is 150 or above and primary schools have been provided within a radius of 1 km.
