The main reasons	for the surrend	er of fund und	er TSPs are said below.

- (a) The tribal population are concentrated in far- flung isolated tribal pockets. Due to this topographical/ geographical constrains and the huge communication gap, the works proposed at this isolated pockets are not carried out in a befitting manner which results in surrender of fund.
- (b) The construction agencies has to transport the construction materials like cement ,steel, aggregates etc from Port Blair which results in non completion of work in prescribed time period and as such the surrender is un avoidable.

Financial:

33. 55 schools are established in tribal habitations for the benefits of tribal population spread out through out the territory. An amount of Rs. 337.25 Lakhs has been spent by the department for running and maintenance of this school network during the last financial year.

General:

The department of education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration 35 is having a network of two Ashram Schools. Out of this, 01 Ashram School building is newly constructed one and the other one is old one. Both these Ashram School buildings are in a good condition and regular repair works are carried out so as to keep the structure in good condition.
