- (ii) Earmarking for TSP areas of financial resources pooled from Central State and other sources e.g. Central Plan, State Plan, financial institutions, non-plan
- (iii) Preparation of each ITDP/ITDA of an integrated multi-sectoral project report covering protective, developmental and regulatory aspects for the area and the people, taking into consideration the human and material resources of the project area.
- (iv) Putting in place a techno-administrative apparatus suitable for the area and the people.
