	10. Two decades have passed since the first bench-mark survey was required to be conducted. Have the State Government undertaken a second stage survey of that nature? If so, have the data been used for preparation of ITDP project reports and Tribal sub-Plan?
	11. If your State Government has not carried out the second bench-mark survey so far, do you have a schedule therefore? Please give the Commission full information in this regard.
	12. The Study Team on Social Welfare and Welfare of Backward Classes and the Dhebar Commission recommended that a Central Institute of Tribal Welfare may be set up which could coordinate, guide and supervise the work of State TRIs etc. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment had set up in 1998 a Committee to go into the matter and this Committee had made elaborate suggestions for the establishment of a National Institute of Tribal Affairs (NITA). Please let the Commission have your views on the establishment of this Institute.
