	Sentinelese The Sentinelese shall remain isolated as they are now for the decades to come. Onges 1. Reduce morbidly and mortality by intensive health care and genetic engineering to stabilize the Onge population. 2. Transform the Saharan and unhygienic settlement habitat to salubrious and healthy settlement. 3. Acculturate the Onges for the settled pattern of life with priority emphasis on sanitary and clothing habits. The field functionaries shall be the "reference group". 4. Phase out the dole system and the practice of "preparation" of the Onges and their settlement for the visitations. 5. Augment the carrying capacity of the Onge territory. 6. Facilitate and encourage the Onge to continue their agile subsistence activities of hunting, fishing and gathering. 7. Prepare the Onges for the later surplus economy based on arbori-culture and fishery from their subsistence economy. 8. Provide suitable milieu for the acculturation of the Onges so that they are equipped for co-existence with mainstream society. Great Andamanese. 1. The elan vital of the Great Andamanese shall be brought back through their socio-cultural reformation. The marriage alliances shall be within their community in the first instance and with Onges in second instance and not with non-autochthons through these reforms. 2. 'Dole system' shall be phased out and economic self reliance is introduced through surplus economy based on fishery and plantation.
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
