North Eastern Council	
39. The North Eastern Council (NEC) was created by the Government of India through the North Eastern Council Act, 1971. It is constituted as an advisory body to make recommendations with regard to matters of common interest to the seven north-eastern member-states namely, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura in the fields of economic and social planning, inter-state transport and communications and power and flood-control projects. It has been entrusted with the responsibility of formulating a united and coordinated regional plan, distinct from the state's own plans, and reviewing implementation of projects from time to time.	-do-
