

54. What mode or system of education would be specifically relevant for students of primitive tribal groups? Please explain.	The general system of education since it is job oriented.
55. Sports have been becoming popular in the country. In some fields like archery, football, hockey etc., tribal boys and girls have given a good account of themselves. The Commission would like to know from the State Government what arrangements have been made to encourage participation of tribal youth in various sports and games? What financial and other incentives have been given? In which other different ways have they been helped?	A Stadium has been provided at Car Nicobar, the tribal area to conduct sports and games and to provide coaching facilities. Besides the tribal boys and girls are availing sports facilities like velodrome, swimming Pool, Squash court, Tennis Court, Billiards Court and Multipurpose hall at Sports Complex, Port Blair. Two sports hostels have been provided in the UT. Special coaching in various fields has been provided by the Sports Authority of India. Sports articles, kits, cash incentives etc are provided to tribal youth under various schemes. Winners of State School Games 2003 (both tribal boys and girls) are proposed for Bharat Darshan Tour.
56. In youth affairs, the young people are given impetus to participate in different activities like camps, cultural events and the like. Have the State Government been holding such festivals and events in which there have been adequate participation of tribal youth? Please narrate briefly.	The Department conducts regular coaching / training classes for talented youths. Organized Block/District/State level competition. Sent teams to main land to participate in National level competition.
