I am directed to invite a reference to this Administration's letter No. 1-804/2004-TW (PF)/79 dated 27th January, 2006 (copy enclosed) on the subject mentioned above and to say that the approval of the Govt. of India for the draft rules governing grant-in-aid to the Nicobarese Tribal Councils of A & N Islands has not yet been received.

During the current financial year 2006-07 there is a specific provision of Rs. 225.72 lakh to be released as grant-in-aid to the TribalCouncils of Nicoabrese to carry out the developmental works / activities in their areas, but this Administration is unable to release the grant-in-aid for want of the approved grant-in-aid rules.

I am, therefore, to request you kindly to look into the matter and expedite approval of the draft grant-in-aid rules by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs being the Administrative Ministry in consultation with the Ministry of Finance and convey to this Administration at the earliest.
