

5. Raising of scattered plantation in South Andaman for the benefit of Jarawas.

A total of 7500 coconut seedlings and 7500 other fruits plants will be transplanted in the Jarawa area to augment their food resources with an outlay of Rs.2.50 lakh during the IXth Plan period.

2. Animal Husbandry :

1. Establishment of a pig feed mixing unit at Car Nicobar by providing grant-in-aid to the Tribal Council Car-Nicobar.
- Under the IXth Five Year Plan, an outlay Rs.5.00 lakh is proposed to be spent for establishment of a pig feed mixing unit by providing grant-in-aid to tribal council.
2. Establishment of a goat farm at Kamorta.
- An outlay of Rs.10.00 lakh is to proposed to be spent towards establishment of a goat demonstration farm at Kamorta for the benefit of tribals.

3. Fisheries The Department has not formulated any special scheme for the tribal areas in the 9th Five Year Plan. For the development of fisheries in the tribal areas, a total of 7 schemes out of 10 plan schemes formulated for implementation during 9th Five Year Plan will be implemented in the tribal areas. The names of the schemes are as under:-

1. Development of Infrastructure Facilities in A & N Islands.
2. Development of Captive Fisheries.
3. Development of Culture Fisheries.
4. Market Promotion.
5. Fisheries Extension and Training
6. Conservation and Monitoring of Fisheries Resources.
7. Strengthening and Re-organisation of Fisheries Department.
