Prompt action by the
Directorate of Civil Aviation

seriously ill 13 year old boy to
access the much needed
medical treatment from Hut
Bay to GB Pant Hospital.

Soon after receiving a crash
message from the Health
Department today at 1400 hrs
about the seriously ill patient,
the Pawan Hans Helicopter
was pressed into action by the
Department of Civil Aviation
here to evacuate the boy from
PHC, Hut Bay. He was
brought at Port Blair at 1500
hrs and rushed to GB Pant
Hospital, said the Director
(Civil Aviation) in a release
here.

Facility for Treatment of Jarawas at PHC, Kadamtala

Port Blair, Nov 10
An Eco-friendly hut
using cane and bamboo
materials was constructed in
the premises of the Public
Health Centre, Kadamtala in
the year April 2000 at an
expenditure of Rs. 74,082/-,
which includes Rs. 26,031
towards internal electrical
installation. Subsequently the
following facilities viz Paca
approach footpath-cum-
steps, drain, bathing place
with overhead tank were
provided for the use of the
Jarawas at an expenditure of
Rs. 3,51,386/-. Hospital staff

has been rendering service to
the Jarawas whenever
hospitalisation is required.
Jarawas are provided with
special diet suitable for them
during their period of stay in
the PHC. Approximately
Rs.2,58,490 had been spent
during the last 5 years toward
food items provided to the
Jarawas during hospitaliza-
tion.
