

- (c) The Executive Council of AAJS assisted by experts and persons having knowledge and experience in tribal affairs under the Chairmanship of Lt. Governor will enforce and monitor implementation of the policy.
- (d) Meaningful research on the Jarawas will be allowed under the advice of AAJS to further the understanding of their life and culture including their traditional knowledge. However, it shall be ensured strictly that the confidentiality of genetic resources on the Jarawas will be maintained and not used for commercial exploitation by any agency or organization which is not directly concerned with the welfare and protection of the Jarawas.
- (e) Periodic review of this policy will be done so that the policy is dynamic and takes into account changing needs and circumstances.
