Sub: - Violation of Supreme Court order and Marginalization of Jarwas- letter from Secretary, National Advisory Council.

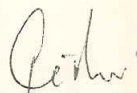
Sir,

With regard to issues like undertaking construction of mud walls to keep off tsunami and environmental clearances before embarking upon such project, it is stated that this Administration will be sending a reply separately.

As for exploitation of Jarawas and instances of poaching, it may be pointed out that there have been stray instances of exploitation of Jarawas and poaching. In this context the law enforcement agencies like Police and Forest Department have been instructed to be vigilant to prevent exploitation of Jarawas and poaching in the Jarawas reserve area.

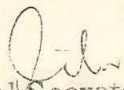
