community. It will have serious ramification in the interpersonal relationship of the community itself and is bound to be counter productive in the shape of violence. There is, therefore, an urgent need to assess the seriousness of such disturbing behavioral change. It would also need to be addressed to, for bringing about the desired correction. This kind incident of sexual violence by the male Jarawas against the women folk of their own community had never come to the notice in the past.

9. On shifting the Jarawas from Jirkatang to R.K.Nallah and to Tirur and vice versa in the pick-up van provided by the AAJVS, my observation is that it increases the frequency of their presence in Tirur areas and the resulting in the corresponding increase in the incidents of plunderings in the adjoining settlement areas. The police personnel, have, therefore, been directed not to transport the JARWAS from R.K.Nallah-Jirkatang areas to Tirur and viceversa.

It is therefore requested that necessary action taken or propose to be taken may kindly be intimated.
