

8. Exploitation of the Jarawas in whatever form by non-tribals will be prevented. No exploitation of natural resources within the Jarawa reserve by any non-tribal including government agencies will be allowed.
9. Unauthorized entry of non-tribals into Jarawa reserve will be strictly prevented from both land and sea front by law enforcement agencies.
10. Employees of Departments of Tribal Welfare, Forest and Police will be suitably reoriented as advised by Andaman Adm Janjati Vikas Samiti, from time to time.
11. Officials/workers engaged in the protection and welfare of Jarawas will be regularly screened to ensure that they are absolutely free from communicable diseases.
12. Traffic on Andaman Trunk Road will be regulated strictly limiting the traffic to the essential purposes of public transport, supplies and emergency evacuation of patients and to ensure that it is an innocent and harmless passage and not a source of trouble to Jarawas.
13. Vehicles on Andaman Trunk Road will move only in restricted hours and in convoy under notified speed limit to avert possible road accidents and to avoid any sort of interaction of travellers with Jarawas.
14. Maintenance of the Andaman Trunk Road will be carried out by a mobile maintenance team bringing men machine and materials from Ferrargunj / Jirkatang and carry out the job only during day time.
15. Nutritional and food security survey of the Jarawas will be conducted every year.
16. Periodic health survey of the Jarawa community will be organized through a Standing Team of health professionals. Only cases needing intensive care will be brought to the hospital but they will be kept in separate enclosures. Appropriate food will be provided instead of the hospital meals. Whenever female Jarawas come or are brought to hospital, female Police will be posted invariably.
17. The Medical intervention among the Jarawas i.e. the line of treatment, use of drugs and medicines will be only on the basis of advice of the experts in the relevant fields.
