

The work was completed in April 2001 within the estimated cost as per the utilization certificate from the Executive Engineer, Construction Division-I, Rangat) a copy is placed at page 23/C).

Further an amount of Rs.26,031/- was spent towards Internal Electrical Installation in the Jarawa Ward Vide utilization certificate of the Executive Engineer, Construction Division-I, Rangat, placed at page 24/C.

Thus the total expenditure towards the establishment of the Jarawa Ward works out to Rs.4,25,468/- (Rs.48,051/- + Rs.3,51,386/- + Rs.26,031/-)

Besides, AAJVS is incurring expenditure on the following activities:-

- i) Deployment of two vehicles on hire, one on ATR covering Tirur and Jirkatang and other in Kadamtala area for patrolling to control the movement of the Jarawas and also to protect the Jarawas from intrusion of non-tribals. The average expenditure is Rs.30,000/- per month for both the vehicles. A total amount of Rs.1,74,430/- has been spent up to 30.09.2004 during the current financial year.

- ii) Deployment of 4 motorcycles: A total expenditure of Rs.48,824/- has been incurred during the current financial year on running & maintenance of motorcycles.

The following staffs viz.. Tribal Welfare Officer, Kadamtala, Plantation-in-charge, Baratang, Pharmacist, Kadamtala and Research Investigator, Jirkatang are using the motorcycles for Official duties.

- iii) Providing nutritious food etc to the Jarawas during hospitalization. We have so far spent Rs.1,09,162/- during the current financial year.

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
