Andamanese Multipurpose Coop. Society located in this island Educational facilities have been established and the malliterate among the Great Andamanese is a student who reached the fifth standard. The total number of students the school is 11. Some of them have also been given Government employment in the police.

Onges

The Onges, who also belong to the Negrito group, hav traditionally been located in Little Andaman in an area call. Dugong Creek and South Bay. Since they were scattered over Little Andaman, with the resettlement of East Bengal refugee: on this island in 1974, two Onge settlements were created at Dugong Creek and South Andaman in this island, and they were regrouped and settled here. Today their number is 97. again the Andaman Adima Janjati Vikas Samiti administers cooperative society known as the Onge Multipurpose Cooperative Society for their welfare. A Primary School has been established in Dugono Creek, and Onge children are admitted to this school located there sitself, and they have reached the 3rd Standard. The Ongestare engaged on a coconut plantation raised by the Administration and administered by the Andamas. Adim Janjathi Vika's Samiti. They also hunt wild pigs, turtle and are engaged in the collection of honey.

Both the Great Andamanese and the Onges (like the Mongoloid Nicobarese and Shompens) are registered on the voters list and have voted in last year's General Elections.
