After treatment he was returned to his tribal habital However, as a result, he did become a source of information for his fellow tribesmen on the outside world, and this ha manifested itself during the last one year in that la. number of Jarawas began appearing at non-tribal locations. Uttara Jetty in Middle Andaman, and from August, 1998 onward in Tirur Police Post in South Andaman Island. On all suc occasions they were returned to the forest, after giving the gifts such as coconuts and bananas. In the month of September 1998 nearly 15 Jarawas including women and children were four at Middle Andaman in seriously sick condition. Some of the appeared to have respiratory problems, while others had acut. dehydration problems. These sick Jarawas were transported in the GB Pant Hospital in Port Blair and treated for nearly three weeks. Once they were restored to normal health, the were escorted back to their habitat in the forests. After these two incidents of medical treatment, no other attempt at fraternisation of the Jarawas was initiated by Administration except for the contact teams periodicali visiting their areas as has been the practice over the last 2 years. It may be mentioned here that Shri Enmay and Smti Enmay had also been introduced to the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Atal Behari Vajpayee at Port Blair on 31st December, 1998 and again on 1st January, 1999.

From the month of September, 1998 onwards large numbers of Jarawas; including women and children began 4 appear at Tirur outpost in South Andaman, and also along the
