We your petitioner states that instead of detecting the actual problem of the aboriginal JARAWAS which was the bounded duty of the respondent Administration they slept over the matter without providing them sufficient scope for their food by way plantation of various fruit bearing trees like banana, coconut etc. Not only that Bush police who are posted in JARAWA areas so that outsiders may not disturb them, totally
