

V) For that the respondent authorities are fully

equipped for providing all sorts of assistance and / or help to them having all infrastructure and finance but for unknown reason they are playing with the life of JARWAS, whereas the respondent authorities through their regular contacts since

1976 raised their expectancy that they will be provided assistance by the Administration.

VI) For that until and unless immediate help as

regard food, water and medicine are provided by the respondent Administration to them they will

die out of starvation and sickness and the remnant will become either beggar or trouble maker to the

civilized society itself.

VII) For that most important thing is that they

are not at all uninvited guests, they have equal right like any other citizen of India for

protection of life and personal liberty and the State is under obligation to follow certain policy for them raising the level of nutrition and the

standard of living and to improve the health. Otherwise that will be violative of Article 14,

21, 39, 47 & 49A of the Constitution of India.
