Let a Rule issue. Returnable by four weeks from date in terms of the prayers (A) and (B) to the application. Mr. R.S. Saroop, learned Govt. Counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents. An additional copy of the application be served upon Mr. Saroop learned Govt. Counsel.

Let Affidavit-in-opposition be filed within three weeks from date and Affidavit-in-reply thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.

We appoint Dr. B.S. Banerjee, Director of Information, Publicity and Tourism, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, and Shri N.C. Roy, Secretary, Tribal Welfare Department, Port Blair, as Special Officers of this Court, and request them to submit a report as regards the problems faced by the Jarawa Community and ways and means which can be envisaged for their rehabilitation and/or settlement, by the next date fixed fixed. In the meantime, the Respondent No. 3 is directed to render all medical facilities to the members of Jarawa Community, if any necessity arises therefor.

Mr. B.K. Das, and learned Counsel, and Mr. A.K. Ray, learned Counsel, request for intimation in the matter. They are permitted to do so.

Let plain copies of the order, duly countersigned by the Asst. Registrar (Court), be made available to the learned Counsel, appearing for the parties as also the Intervener.
