

lead to ultimate destruction of their culture, their vitality and even their physical existence.

(c) Provide the Jarawas with the food / cooked food so that they do not come into the non-tribal areas.

(d) Even after providing the food to the Jarawas they would still continue to come out into the villages and ATR as they are attracted to the out side world and they may even simply come for the sake of fun.

(e) Giving of such free food / dole will certainly kill their self reliance, vitality and may be their race as a whole as their society would set on to decline and decay with the introduction of alms by out siders.

(f) Loss due to plundering by the Jarawas be compensated by the Administration.

(g) Strengthen the Police force and intensify the Police patrolling to prevent the Jarawas coming out and mixing with the non-tribal people. If they come into the villages / ATR they should dropped back as quickly as possible into their own territory.

(h) Further intensification of patrolling on the ART to control the Jarawas coming on to the roads and their by preventing possible road accident involving the Jarawas.

(i) Involve only the dedicated Govt. Officials to handle the Jarawa matters. However the public representatives can be involved in the form of Committees etc. to over see the Jarawa situation and its management.

(j) Continue the present programme of enrichment of Jarawa territory including the sea and sea creeks. This will augment the food resources and prevent possible shortages of food for the Jarawas.
