

(s) A Task Force / Core Group needs to be constituted which would be capable to take appropriate decision to tackle the developing Jarawa situation from time to time. This force would consist of (i) IGP (ii) PCCF (iii) Secretary (FW) (iv) DC,

(r) Such measures to stop the traffic on the ATR may not result in the desired consequences since they would continue to come to villages through the jungle. So patrolling on the ATR needs intensification to prevent the road accident involving the Jarawas.

(q) Stop traffic on the Andaman Trunk Road atleast for some time to avoid road accidents.

(p) Integrate the Jarawas with the civilization.

(o) It is not proper to engage the Jarawas as a labourers in the activities they are not direct beneficiaries / relevant to them like roads etc., and they would be susceptible for exploitation by the unscrupulous agencies. On the other hand they could be involved in the activities relating to the enrichment of their territory. The Jarawas could be compensated in kind like food items etc. in return of their participation in the enrichment of their own territory.

(n) Engage the Jarawas in the Labour force to work on the civil works like roads etc.

(m) Provide medical cover to the Jarawas and also prevent the spread of new diseases among the Jarawas from the non-tribal peoples / out-siders.

(l) Some selected handicrafts and artisanship could be tried among the Jarawas gradually by utilising the locally available materials like bamboo, cane etc.

(k) Officials to learn the Jarawa language and also teach the Jarawas particularly the children the Hindi language to have functional communication with the Jarawas.
