

1) As soon as Jarawas reach non-tribal areas or other prohibited place to isolate them from the non-tribals.

2) The gift items like coconuts, bananas etc. in a very limited quantity will be presented to the Jarawas and they will be sent back to their habitat as soon as possible to avoid their mingling with the non-tribals. Very limited quantity of gifts are suggested to wear away the Jarawas for their recent habit of frequent visits to non-tribal areas.

3) The committee will ensure that whenever the Jarawas come, they are not surrounded by the people in large number and nobody shall be allowed to present them clothes and other exotic items including exotic food items to avoid health hazard among the Jarawas.

4) The gift items will be stored by AAJVS in the Police Outposts time to time for presenting the same to the Jarawas as and when they visit. In case of dearth of gift item the committee will procure the same locally and forward the bills to AAJVS after verification of the purchase of gift items locally. It is to be ensured that the same are procured as per the local market till the tenders are finalised.

5) Management of Jarawas on their arrival be started immediately by the Convener and inform other members quickly. Members who could reach the spot, will manage the affairs and action taken will be inform to other members as soon as possible.
