

13. The team consisting of the Officials of the Forest, Fisheries, Agriculture, AAJVS and Police could go to the Western coasts of South Andaman Island by M.V. Milale (in her absence DSS could provide an alternate vessel for the said purpose) to raise the dispersed plantation and to carry out the ranching of sea and creek. The gifts could be given there to the Jarawas when they participate in this activities of resources augmentation.

14. This activity on the Western coasts will encourage the Jarawas to return to their usual area i.e. on the Western coasts and thereby the danger of inter face with the non-Jarawas on the ATR would be reduced considerably.

(Action: ES, AAJVS, PCCF, SP(D), DSS)

15. It is observed that owners of the stalls / shops which come up during the day time at the Middle Strait encourage / advise the passenger and the vehiclists to take the eatables that they sell to others to give to the Jarawas while they are travelling in the Jarawa areas like R.K. nallah etc. Apparently these shop keepers are exploiting the situation and exploring the possibility of widening their market even to the Jarawas. In this context comments / report from the Police and the District Administration could be called.
