

May please see the office notes from para 136/n onwards. It is regarding sanction of grant-in-aid under central sector scheme of development of the Primitive Tribal Groups (PTGs). As mentioned vide item No. (ii) at pge 320/c of the minutes of the meeting of the selection committee held on 19.11.99 in the Ministry of SJ&E, New Delhi, the proposal for establishment of staging posts for the welfare of the Jarawas submitted to the GOI vide this Administration's letter dated 14.10.99 at page 280/c was considered. The selection committee has observed that detailed clarifications and justification on all component of the proposal are required to be sent to the GOI and also this Administration is required confirm that the committed liability of the project in future shall be fully borne by the Administration when no grants would be available from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.

The project relating the establishment of staging posts is an integrated approach towards the welfare of the Jarawas. The following departments viz. Tribal Welfare / AAJVS, Health, Forest and Police are concerned with the implementation of the project. Each staging post will be manned by a Tribal Welfare Officer, a teacher, a pharmacist, a forest, police guards with communication equipments and a few group D staff. The department-wise staff proposed to be deployed to each of the staging post is as follows

(1) **Police Department**

- (i) Circle Inspector (Rs. 6500-10,500) - 1
- (ii) Sub-Inspector (Rs. 5500-9000) - 2
- (iii) Head Constable (Rs. 3060-5900) - 8
- (iv) Constable (Rs. 2075-4050) - 24

(2) **Health Department**

- (i) Pharmacist (Rs. 4000-6000) - 4

(3) **Tribal Welfare / AAJVS**

- (i) Tribal Welfare Officer (Rs. 6500 (Consolidated)) - 4

- (4) Special Assistant (Rs. 3050-4090) - 2

- (i) Assistant (Rs. 2550-3200) - 2

- (5) Boat Engine Driver (Rs. 2650-3200) - 2

- (6) LGC (Rs. 4000-6500) - 2

- (7) Group D staff (Rs. 2550-3200) - 24

- (8) Sweeper (Rs. 2550-3200) - 3
