

These Officers will inspect the working of the Staging Posts and record their observations / suggestions.

As discussed in the meeting held at Raj Nivas on 4.3.99 there shall be an Overseer Committee consisting of public representatives like Pradhan of concerned Gram Panchayat, Swpanch, Member of Panchayat Samithy, Member of Zila Parishad. This Committee shall over see the implementation of various decisions / measures to tackle the Jarawa issue.

The Task Force consisting of the following shall supervise to ensure the implementation of various decisions relating to the welfare of Jarawas.

- (i) Inspector General of Police.
- (ii) Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.
- (iii) Secretary (TW)
- (iv) Deputy Commissioner, Andamans.
- (v) Head of Office of ASI.
- (vi) Director of Health Services.
- (vii) Director (TW).
- (viii) Executive Secretary, AAJVS.

As decided in the meeting the Research and Development Cell shall advise the Administration and the Task Force on continuous basis on all the matters relating to Jarawas.

Each Staging Posts shall have a mini truck with cover / hood, collapsible benches. This vehicle shall be used for the transportation of men and materials including gifts. 4 Nos of mini truck could be purchased out of the fund provided to AAJVS under Special Central Assistance. These trucks can be handed over to the Police for their use and further maintenance. It could be driven by the Police driver.

It is desirable to keep the vehicles under Police so that its mobilisation is effective. If it is not possible to mobilise Police drivers within the existing strength, 4 Nos. of drivers could be appointed on contract basis by the Police. The funds required towards the salary could also be met out of the fund available with AAJVS.

The communication equipments like VHF Hand Sets (6 Nos.) and Repeater stations wherever required could be provided for establishing communication with Police Headquarters / Administration etc. by each Staging Post. The fund required for procurement of the equipment could be mobilised out of those available / to be provided to AAJVS.

Following the receipt of the fund the same could be allocated to Inspector General of Police for the procurement of

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
