

The matter was discussed with Lt. Governor on 25.3.99. The Jarawa reserved area prior to 1957 was approximately 368 sq.miles which was notified by the Administration vide Notification No. 3 dated 2.4.1957, copy of the Notification is placed at Page-190/c. The Tribal reserved area was reduced to approximately 250 sq. miles in 1979 through the Notification of the Administration vide No. 1077/F.No.40-247/78-TW dated 19th July, 1979, copy of the Notification is placed at page-192/c.

In this context maps indicating the Jarawa areas are placed at Page-193 & 194/c. The area shown by pink wash (colour) indicates the Jarawa area as per 1979 Notification. As per 1957 Notification the area shown in brown colour indicates Jarawa Reserved area which was in addition to the area shown by pink colour. In other words the area shown in the brown colour is de-reserved through the Administration Notification of 1979.

Further in this context may please refer to the observation of Chief Secretary at para 18/n. A detailed report with regard to the Jarawa situation has been sent to the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment under the Signature of Secretary (TW) by fax on 25.3.1999 and again by the speed post. The copy of the report sent is placed at Page 168/c to 181/c.
