- Lime Stone Cave, Mud Volcano and Parrot Island are eco-tourism sites in the forest area. Eco-tourism is one of the approved Plan Schemes of the Department of Environment & Forests, A&N Administration.
- The Department is not undertaking any commercial activities in these sites and is maintaining the sites even prior to the A&N Administration's Notification F.No.1-752/2007-TW dated 30.10.2007 declaring buffer zone for the Tribal Reserve.
- 3. Lime Stone Cave and Mud Volcano are geologically important sites and research activities are being conducted by reputed National Institutes at these sites. Scientific data on the emission of gases are being collected at Mud Volcano regularly.
