Resorts, Sundargarh, Baratang to this office in the month of June, 2008

the administration initiated to issue the revised guidelines in compliance

case was examined on the basis of existing guidelines on the subject.

since the revised guidelines have not been referred upto the month of

October, 2008. Meanwhile the revised guidelines issued by the

Administration vide order no. 4192 dated 15.11/2008 were received

wherein many new conditions and requirements were inserted and the

application was examined in view of these guidelines and the applicant

was directed to comply with the revised guidelines. Reports were called

from Assistant Commissioner Mayanunder/Tejstidar, Rangat from

revenue point of view and Dy.S.P, Middle Andaman, Bambapool from

police angle.

Whereas on completion of formalities of the guidelines a press
note was issued on 15/10/2007 in the city public objection before
issue of the bar licence in response to prevent a complaint from Shri
Sunit Kumar, K/o Gopal Khatun, Rangat, was received stating that the
area is inhabited by local people of Chakringpur recognized as ST
community by Central Government, the community is vulnerable to
exploitation by non-local people and hence need protection from the
Government. The area is very near to the reserved by Jomwa
reserve forest (Kodumolli Reserve and Jomwa Reserve). The
primitive forest will be exposed to damage.
