

SLP (Civil) 12125/2010 Andaman Nicobar Admn. & Ors. versus M/s Barefoot Inns & Leisure Pvt. Ltd. came up for hearing on 25.11.2011 in the Supreme Court. Application seeking extension of time for submission of amendment of PAT Regulation sought by the Administration has been filed on the day of hearing. Ms. Indira Jaisingh, Additional Solicitor General of India placed before the Hon'ble Court about the steps taken by the Administration for the protection of the Jarawa Tribes, ATR position, villages settled in the Buffer Zone area and about the commercial activities catering the basic needs of the villages.

The Hon'ble Judge after hearing the factual position, dictated interim order for constituting Advocate Commission for enquiring in the details and submission of report in the Supreme Court after visiting these Islands. While dictating the order, I could not hear the time limit if any, fixed for the Commission for submission of report.

The interim order of the Hon'ble Court is not yet placed in the Supreme Court's website. The above position is intimated to Shri T. Narasimhan, Under Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs today by fax.
