I am directed to refer Ministy's letter No.U-11023/1/2010-UTL dated 22^{nd} November, 2011 addressed to the Pr.Secretary(TW), A&N Admn. enclosing therein a letter dated 16.11.2011 from Ms.Indira Jaisingh, Additional Solicitor General.

The Additional Solicitor General of India has mentioned about the tourist activities around the mud-volcano and limestone cave. In this regard, it is submitted that the Administration has already admitted on 13/12/2010 while filing the reply before the Supreme Court that the nature based tourism activities were promoted by the Andaman Nicobar Admn. to showcase the natural wealth of this Islands which includes the limestone cave and mud-volcano in Baratang Island.

The Administration has submitted the final draft proposal to the Ministry for the amendment of the PAT Regulation on 19/11/2011 defining the commercial activities/tourist establishments in the proposed draft for amendment, after discussion with Home Secretary on 14/11/2011.

The Administration has reduced the number of convoys passing through the Jarawa reserve area on Andaman Trunk Road from 8 to 4. The Jarawa Policy of 2004 is under review and more systematic studies and research on the life of the tribal community, documentation of various aspect of tribal life and their need on a vis changing scenario will be taken up. The research work shall be carried out in consultation and association with the Anthropological Survey of India.

We have also prepared an affidavit giving all these facts, for the $25^{\rm th}$ Nov, 2011 hearing. (copy enclosed for reference). The undersigned has been deputed to brief the Additional Solicitor General on $24^{\rm th}$ Nov, 2011 as well and will be present during the hearing.
