to windows and standing on sideboards or hanging off the back of vehicles.

- b. On 15th January 2011, travelling between Jirkatang and Middle Strait on the Andaman Trunk Road, the Respondents' vehicle along with others was held up in a roadblock by 4 Jarawa children who attempted to board the vehicles and snatched items such as snacks and in one instance a child's toy from a car. This interaction was unsupervised as the lead motorcycle and the vehicle carrying the police escort had gone ahead. Further along the road, one vehicle had a flat tyre but the supposedly 'regulated' convoy carried on ahead, leaving the occupants of the vehicle and nearby Jarawa in close proximity and unsupervised.
- c. During the return journey between Middle Strait and Jirkatang on 17th January 2011, a single unescorted Jarawa was interacting freely with tourists waiting for the convoy to depart from Middle Strait and he was also seen by the Respondent to be mobbed by a busload of tourists who arrived in the incoming convoy from Jirkatang at 0800hrs. Further along the road, after the convoy had departed, 2 vehicles were spotted parked along the road, within a proximity of approximately 300 meters from a group of 5 Jarawa youths and the driver of one of vehicles was changing a tyre and the others had alighted from their vehicles and there was no police escort in this supposedly "regulated" "convoy".
